MELBOURNE ACCOMMODATION AND TRAVEL INFORMATION

Visas – Consult your travel agent or consular officials to ensure you have arranged entry visas well in advance.

Taxi - Transfer by taxi from Tullamarine Airport to the city centre takes approximately 30 minutes and costs approximately \$30.00

Sky Bus - The airport shuttle operates daily between the Airport and Spencer Street Station. Airport pick up Ground Floor outside the International Terminal - Bus departs every 1/2 hour - Cost : Adult \$12 one way adult return \$21 (open ticket). Approximately 30 minutes travel time.

Tram – City Circle Trams circle the perimeter of the central business district every day. The free City Circle service runs every 10 minutes in both directions from 10am to 6pm Sun - Wed and to 9.30pm every Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Call 131 638 for an update on operating hours of this free service.

Accommodation – Melbourne is a modern city of over 3 million people and has a thriving central business district with many fine hotels. However, January is a vacation period for a large section of the population and, moreover, the conferences are being held at the time of the Australian Tennis Open. Delegates are urged to book accommodation as early as possible. The web site contains pointers to hotels in the area of the conference venue.

Weather – January in Melbourne is mid-summer. However, Melbourne has a climate where the weather can change rather rapidly. Days of 40 degrees Celcius are possible. At the other extreme, the temperature will rarely dip below 20 degrees Celcius. Daytime temperatures are usually between 20 and 30 degrees Celcius. The average daily maximum is around 26 and the average daily minimum is around 13.
